PURPOSE

NMD Foundation is funding scholarships for South Carolina residents only, in order to recognize young, talented individuals with type one diabetes who demonstrate an ability to balance academic, sporting commitments and the daily challenges that T1D brings. Preference will be given to student athletes who want to use their sport to educate, empower and inspire, and support families already burdened with additional expenses associated with diabetes care.

Awardees will receive this one-time, \$1,000 scholarship, at the start of their freshman year, paid directly to the university/college/technical or trade school

The selection process for applications is based on the following criteria:

- The applicant has type one diabetes, confirmed in writing by a doctor
- The applicant maintains a GPA of 3.0 or better
- The applicant is actively involved in the type one diabetes community
- The applicant will be attending an accredited four-year university, college, technical or trade school
- The applicant can demonstrate they are successfully managing the challenges of living with type one diabetes
- **Preference will be given to those applicants who will be participating in an NCAA/NAIA sport and will use their sport as a platform to inspire other T1D's**

Applications, along with a photo, current certified GPA and two written references; one relating to your sport (i.e., from a coach) and one from a member of your community highlighting your community involvement, should be mailed to NMD Foundation/Scholarship at [94 Pine Ridge Drive Bluffton, SC 29910](#) or e-mailed by pdf attachment to nmdfoundation@gmail.com.



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Selection process: The NMD Board of Directors will review all applications and will unanimously select the winners based on the selection process.
